Vinification & aging

All the grapes of the varieties that contribute to the production of the blend have been harvested at technological and phenolic maturity. They were then destemmed and fermented at a controlled temperature of 26 °C for about 10 days using selected yeasts. To complete the alcoholic fermentation, malolactic fermentation was performed. Finally, the wine was aged for 6 months in stainless steel tanks on fine lees acquiring greater complexity and structure.

Bright ruby red.

Nose
Aromatic profile characterized by citrus notes of Mandarin, lemon and grapefruit, accompanied by fruity nuances of white peach and pear. The olfactory bouquet is enriched by floral nuances and a subtle mineral composition.

Taste
The wine has a good freshness and a balanced structure with a leg-ger and pleasant tannins.

Curiosity about the wine's name

The Latin translation of "serpent", the name draws inspiration from the deep historical and symbolic connection with the cult of Juno Sospita, an ancient protective deity. Since the first half of the 7th century BC, the great sanctuary dedicated to the goddess was a spiritual center renowned throughout antiquity for its extraordinary rituals. Among them stood out the cult of the sacred serpent – a creature revered as a divine manifestation and as a symbol of fertility, abundance, and protection.
